Submission Information

We are now accepting artwork for the 5 x 5 (x5) Silent Auction event! There is no entry fee to submit/donate your work. Please note that the following rules and conditions apply.

- You may submit up to five (5) entries.
- Art must be original work and comply with the 5 inch square specification. No part of the work should extend beyond the 5"x5" limit.
- 2D works should be on unframed gallery wrapped 1-1/2" deep canvases.
- 3D works must fit within a 5"x5"x5" space.
- One 5 x 5 gallery wrapped, 1-1/2" deep, canvas is available at no charge to the artist and may be picked up at On the Hill Gallery. Additional gallery wrapped canvases are available at the gallery for \$5 ea.
- All artwork is due to gallery no later than **Saturday September 1, 2018**
- Please keep in mind that this is a family-friendly event.
- Unsold artwork becomes the property of the Yorktown Arts Foundation

Your small works donation will help us to continue programs such as our free summer kids' art camps, veterans' art shows, York County Schools art shows, support of emerging artists, #FoundinYorktown abandoned art and will help us develop new creative opportunities for our community.
